First Nations Housing Strategy

- Indigenous Services Canada was mandated by Cabinet in December 2016 to engage with Indigenous partners to develop distinctions-based housing strategies.
- AFN Resolution 87 was approved by the Chiefs in Assembly in December 2017 seeking the co-development of a National First Nations Housing and Infrastructure Strategy.

What We Heard: First Nations Housing Strategy

- Skills/Capacity: build and mobilize capacity for home owners, housing managers, technicians and Band leadership - what organizations, tools and information exist that can be adapted and accessed by others.
- Funding/financing: new, predictable, flexible funding for construction AND for governance, capacity and innovation.
- Data and needs assessments: current state, gaps and projections (housing stock, capacity, related infrastructure, population changes).
